

Chubb Limited 2026 Annual General Meeting Voting Results

The company convened an annual general meeting of shareholders on May 21, 2026, pursuant to notice duly given. The matters voted upon at the meeting and the results of such voting are set forth below.

Under the company's Articles of Association, shareholder approval of proposals is generally determined by simple majority of votes cast, such that abstentions and broker non-votes are disregarded in the tabulation of the vote to determine approval. At the 2026 annual general meeting, abstentions and broker non-votes were not considered in the tabulation of the vote (and thus should be disregarded) for each of Agenda Items 1 through 8, and 10 through 13. Agenda Item 9 required approval of two-thirds of the votes present, which means that abstentions had the same effect as votes against the agenda item.
