

Small Business Confirmation Form - For NSW Stamp Duty Exemption



For certain insurance products NSW stamp duty is exempt for small businesses with aggregate turnover less than \$2 million per annum.

Brokers can ensure clients get the exemption by confirming that they received the small business declaration from their clients.
