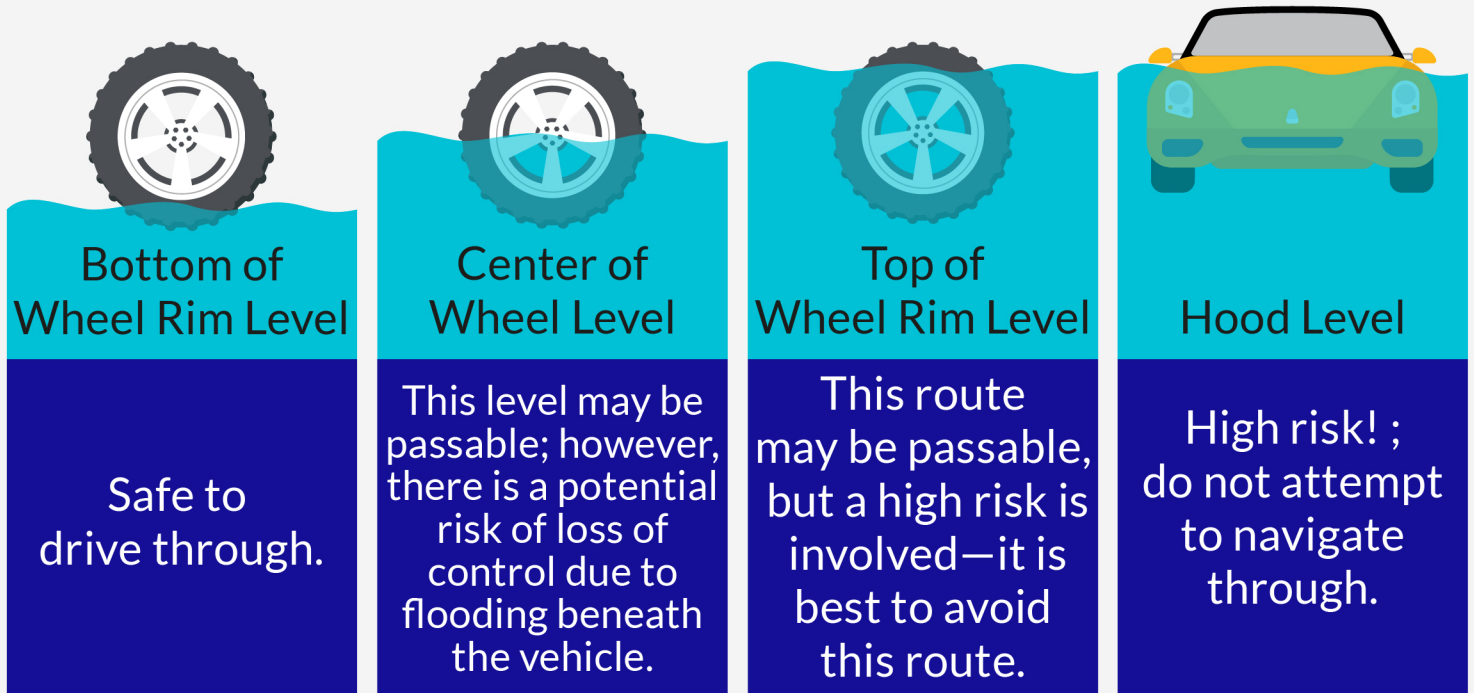





Guidelines for Safely Driving Through Flooded Areas





Precautions for Driving Through Water


- 

Drive below 40 km/h, keeping a steady pace to prevent water from entering the engine.
- 

Turn off the AC to prevent water from drawing into the engine compartment, which can cause the engine to stall.
- 

Maintain a distance from the vehicle in front for 2-3 times greater than usual to minimize the risk of collision.
- 

If your vehicle stalls in a flooded area, do not attempt to restart the engine, as this could damage the electrical system and engine.
- 

Pump brakes after flooding to remove water from the brake pads.
- 

Run the engine for at least 5 minutes to help expel any trapped water and moisture from the engine compartment and exhaust system.
